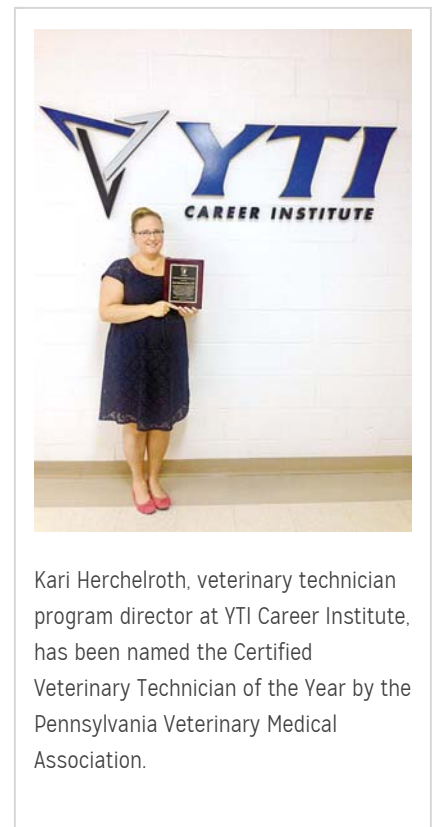

Herchelroth Receives Award

YTI Career Institute has announced that Kari Herchelroth, veterinary technician program director, was named the Certified Veterinary Technician of the Year by the Pennsylvania Veterinary Medical Association (PVMA). PVMA presented the award at its 2017 Hall of Fame Awards Luncheon on Aug. 10 in Hershey. The award is presented annually by the PVMA to a member for an outstanding achievement in veterinary technology.

Herchelroth, a resident of Marietta, began working in the veterinary field in 2000 as an assistant and received her degree in veterinary medical technology from Wilson College in 2003. From there, she worked at an animal hospital in Mount Joy as a certified veterinary technician until 2012 before joining YTI Career Institute as the school's first program director of the veterinary technician program.

In her position at YTI Career Institute's York campus, Herchelroth oversees a staff of 11 and a student body of more than 150 students. She also led the program through its American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) accreditation process in 2014 and has been named both Employee of the Term and Staff Member of the Term.
