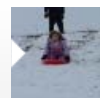

Lancaster County student shadows governor's chef

Culinary arts student works in governor's residence

HARRISBURG, Pa. — A Lancaster County student who has made cooking his passion was given a unique opportunity in Harrisburg.

Andrew Hershey, 19, looks like he fits right in working in a kitchen. Thursday was his first day on the job working for Pennsylvania's first family.

Hershey spent the day shadowing Barry Crumlich, executive chef at the governor's residence.

"Right now, I am making beef wellingtons, putting a little beef tip in with a mushroom, shallot, garlic puree," Hershey said. "We'll have a dessert buffet of fresh baked holiday cookies."

Crumlich said it's a big help to have the state's partnership with the Pennsylvania School of Culinary Arts, which brings students into his kitchen.

"(It's good) for the students to be able to come up and work with us and see what we do, but also help us out with manpower in the kitchen," Crumlich said.

On Thursday, the cooking staff served about 70 people. The reception was to thank volunteers who have helped throughout the year. Hershey said while he felt the pressure, it was an honor to work in the kitchen.

"It's a really good environment. I like it here, really enjoy it," Hershey said.

Hershey said he wants to be a chef at the White House.

One of the first lessons he's learning is the kitchen is Pennsylvania's kitchen.

Crumlich and his staff prepare meals, not only for the governor and first lady and their guests, but
